JORDAN DYKSTRA

Jordan Dykstra (b. Sioux City, Iowa, 1985) is a Brooklyn-based violist and composer exploring the performer-composer-listener relationship through the incorporation of conceptual, graphic, and text-based elements. He holds a bachelor's degree from the California Institute of the Arts where he studied with Michael Pisaro and – under the mentorship of Alvin Lucier – completed his master's degree from Wesleyan University. His film music has been heard at numerous film festivals (Cannes, Sundance Film Festival, International Film Festival Rotterdam, TriBeCa Film Festival, Toronto International Film Festival, Art Basel, Melbourne International Animation Festival) and his chamber music has been programmed in venues around the world (Tokyo, Reykjavík, Los Angeles, New York City, Zürich, Portland, Brussels, Berlin, Ano Syros (Greece), Rhode Island, and Texas, amongst others). His album *The Arrow of* Time (New World Records) was listed as one of the best Modern Composition albums of 2020 by The Wire and included in

the list for Best Contemporary Classical Albums of 2020 by Bandcamp. In addition, as a performer he has been heard with bands such as Dirty Projectors, Atlas Sound, A Winged Victory for the Sullen, Valet, and Lucky Dragons. In 2015 Dykstra founded Editions Verde, a small-run cottage industry label exploring the connection between sound and object.
