Performance notes


- I. Score in C, play as written.
- II. Dynamics are quiet throughout.
- III. Each page is one minute in duration.
- IV. Cent deviations with minus (-) written below the note-head and plus (+) above apply only to the individual event and do not carry on.
- V. Entrances are individual unless:
 - 1) Vertical solid line which guides 2 or more entrances/exists
 - 2) Diagonal dotted line which guides specific ordering of entrances
- IV. Clarification about note-heads:
 - 1) whole-note note-heads imply sustained events which last until directed, at times with humming in unison (see minutes 6-9)
 - 2) stemless solid note-heads imply short events
 - 3) "x" note-heads imply noise (i.e. sound without any clear pitch element) and further directions may appear above including a boxed "△" which directs triangle or a boxed "⊙" which directs half finger pressure (some pitch some noise)
